Membership Cards not received within three weeks of purchase need to be reported. Members making reports beyond 35 days of the purchase date will not be eligible for additions to their 12 month Membership cycle.

∞ When purchasing Angler Memberships, please be aware of potential park and lake closures that may impact fishing activities. Additional fees may apply for boat inspections.

* Students must provide proof of student status.

* Senior Partner Pass (must be 62 years or older) includes the single benefit of day-use parking only.
